

Capital High School Face-to-Face Guidelines 2020-21



- The first day of school for all students regardless of their learning platform (eLearning, face-to-face, or virtual) is Tuesday, September 8, 2020.
- Face-to-Face students will operate on an A/B Day schedule. The Bell Schedule is listed below.
- On A-Day, students will go to periods 1,3,5, and 7. On B-Day, students will go to periods 2,4,6, and 8.
- Students may be dropped off as early as 8:00 AM.
- Students will not be released from common areas to report first period until 9:15 AM.
- Breakfast will be served to all students during first period.
- Face-to-Face students must wear a face mask/covering throughout the school day.
- Face-to-Face students must adhere to all Social Distancing Policies and keeping six feet of distance between themselves. Students must comply with 50% restroom occupancy rules, one-way hallways, and one-way stairwells throughout the building.
- Additionally, class changes and afternoon dismissal will be staggered.
- Students that fail to comply with Social Distancing policies any/all of the Social Distancing policies will be referred for eLearning.
- All students must bring their fully charged iPad to school daily.
- All staff and students must be prepared to return to Remote Instruction at any time.
- All Face-to-Face eLearning students are held to the Kanawha County Schools Student Code of Conduct as well as all policies in the 2020-21 Capital High School Student Handbook.
